Mount Gravatt East State School will receive**

\$161,904*

This funding will be used to:

- increase percentage of students in Years 1-6 with student achievement at or above 'C' standard in English to 80% from baseline results in 2017 of 77%
- increase the consistency of high yield strategies through coaching and modelling with the implementation of lead teachers and High Performing Teams (*Dr Pete Stebbins*)
- support the wellbeing of all staff and students for effective engagement.

Our initiatives include:

- leading teacher release one day a week to develop Professional Learning Communities through High Performing Teams with a focus on feedback and coaching
- employing wellbeing teacher aide to support disengaged students, liaise with families, staff and outside organisations and increase student participation through physical, social and emotional wellbeing support
- providing teacher aide support - pre-teaching and Early Years
- team planning release days for English Unit: Unpacking the 'A' Exemplar, Guide to Making Judgment and developing strategies to engage students in feedback and goal setting.
